

Wallpaper Wallet



What You'll Need

- Wallpaper pieces
 - 2– 9" x 7"
 - 4– 8" x 2 1/2"
 - 3– 3 1/4" x 1 1/4"

Tools

- Scissors
- White glue
- Ruler

Instructions

Step 01

Lay the 9x7 inch pieces of wallpaper with the backs together. Leave a 1/2 inch overhang on the long edge. Mark the line of the edge on the back of each piece.

Step 02

Spread glue on the back of one of these pieces of wallpaper. Be sure to get into the corners but do not put glue in the 1/2 inch area.

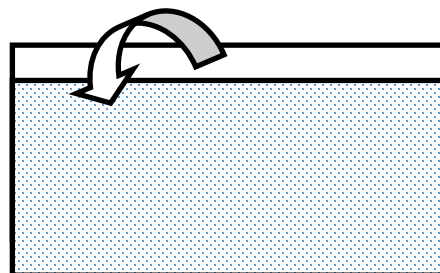
Step 03

Lay the other paper face up on this piece and line up the edge with the drawn line.

Step 04

Fold both of the 1/2 inch edges to the opposite side. Glue these down to the front of the piece.

Step 05

Fold the wallet in half long ways. You may want to weigh this down with books while the glue dries before moving to the next step.

When it is dry, fold it in half again to make the wallet.

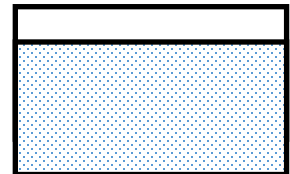
**To make card slots on the wallet continue with the instructions in step 6.
Otherwise, continue on to step 14.**

Card slots

Step 06

Like in step one, take 2 of the 8x2 1/2 inch pieces and lay them backs together. Overhang these 1/4 inch. Draw a line along the edge.

Step 07

Spread glue on the back of one of these pieces of wallpaper. Be sure to get into the corners but do not put glue in the 1/4 inch area.

Step 08

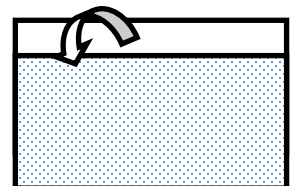
Lay the other paper face up on this piece and line up the edge with the drawn line.

Step 09

Fold the 1/4 inch edges. Glue only 1 of the edges down to the front.

The other edge will be for attaching this to the wallet.

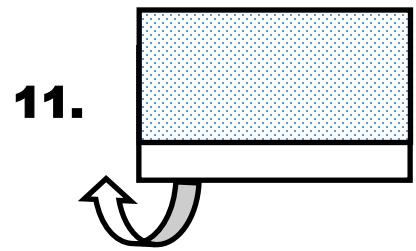
Step 10

Once these pieces have dried, cut them in half to make them 4 inches long.

Repeat these steps for the second set of card slots.

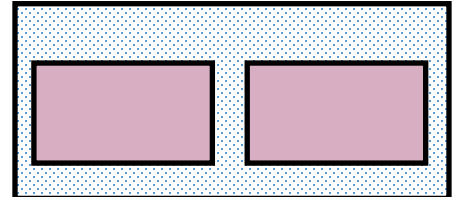
Step 11

Take 1 card slot piece, fold the edge that is not glued backwards and put glue on this.

**Step 12**

Glue this 3/4 inches from the bottom of the wallet on the left side of the wallet. Glue another one on the right side.

**Step 13**

Glue a second card slot just below the first ones.

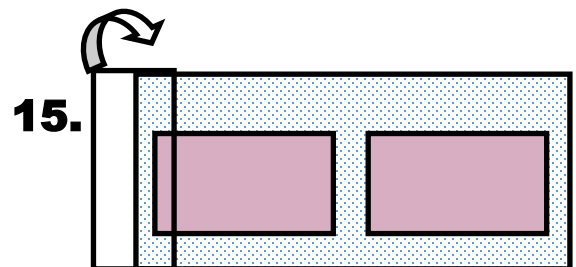
Finishing the wallet

Step 14

Use the small strips of wallpaper to trim the edges of the wallet and card slots. Fold the strips in half the long way.

Step 15

Glue one half on the inside and overlap the card slots. Then glue the other half on the front of the wallet.

**Step 16**

Do the same thing to the other end of the wallet.

Step 17

Glue the last strip in the center of the wallet to hold the card slots in place.
